delve into the basics of poetry writing.

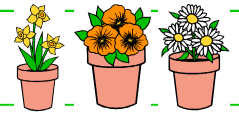
Please register for these workshops by calling (920) 533 - 8534 by Wednesday, April 4 at 6pm. Walk-ins are welcome.
