Local optometrist Dr. Ann Schlaefer and a volunteer group of 15 took 2500 pairs of glasses and sunglasses to the coffee/cocoa bean mountainous area of Nicaragua. They examined eyes and dispensed glasses to 1000 people who do not have any access to eye care. Dr. Ann will give a power point presentation at the Library about the beautiful country of Nicaragua, it's people and the volunteers - several of whom are from the Campbellsport area.
