1000 Books Before Kindergarten

The Campbellsport Public Library is excited to announce the start of a new early literacy program. The concept is simple, the rewards are priceless. The Staff is encouraging parents and caregivers of very young children to read aloud to their children on a regular basis. Research proves that the more children hear books read to them, the more prepared they will be to learn to read upon entering kindergarten.

Come to the Library at anytime to register your 0 - 5 age child for this free self paced program. At registration you will receive instructions and a reading log to record the titles of the first 100 books you read with your child. Once you complete the first goal of reading 100 books, come back to the Library so your child can be recognized for their accomplishment. At this time you will receive your next reading log. Keep reading, every time your child completes a reading milestone they will be recognized for their achievement. When they have completed reading 300 books they will receive a special book bag. When they have completed the program they will be rewarded with a book and a certificate. With parental permission, children will have their photo taken with their prize to put on the Library's Facebook page and possibly in the local newspapers.

If you read just three books a day, you can exceed this goal in just one year! If you need more time, you can take as long as you need. Just finish before your child enters kindergarten.
