Starting Tuesday, September 5th the Campbellsport Library will have a change of operating hours for the school year. The Library will be open:

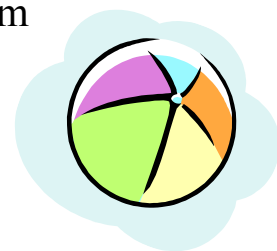


