

Another Busy Year for the Campbellsport Public Library!

During the 2009 year, 52,862 items were checked out by library patrons. This is an increase of 8.1% when compared to 2008. During 2009 we added 3,134 new items to our collection. New items will continue to arrive weekly throughout this year.

The public computer stations were also heavily used. The PCs were used 7,454 times or 9.5% more than the pervious year. This month we have added two new laptops to our building. The staff is confident that these additional computers will alleviate some of wait time and allow patrons to stay on the computer stations longer.

The Library planed and held 131 programs during 2009. These programs were attended by 404 adults and 1,996 children. Some of our programs are held just for fun, like the kids' afterschool movie. Other were held for educational purposes, like the financial courses that were held during *Smart Money Week*.

During the past summer volunteers labeled all the children's books, about 6,600 items, with Accelerated Reader information. Between this undertaking and other small projects, volunteers worked approximately 435 hours. Volunteers are always needed.

The lower level meeting rooms were used 169 times throughout the year. We are very proud of our meeting room space. Groups are invited to use the space for meetings and special activities.

Our website was visited over 24,000 during 2009. Over the year we plan to give our website a face light. Go to www.campbellsportpubliclibrary.org to watch for changes.

The Library owns over 2,500 DVD and VHS movies that are available check-out.

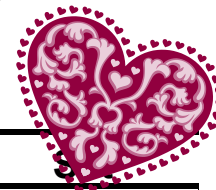

New DVDs are added to the collection on a regular basis. If you want to watch something that we don't have please speak with a staff member. We can help you get what you are looking for.

DVDs and VHS Tapes can be kept free for a 7 day period with a one week renewal period, if no one is waiting for that particular movie. If a DVD is returned passed it's due date the fine is \$1 per day for every day we are open. If VHS Tapes are late it is 25¢ per day. No fine on any specific item can ever exceed \$5.
