Knitting 101

An experienced knitter and seasoned teacher will be offering a learn how to knit class at the Campbellsport Public Library. She will teach participants how to cast on, knit and purl, and bind off.

Participants will need to come to the workshop with a pair of knitting needles. They should be size 8, 9 or 10. Participants should also buy a skein of yard for the class.

It is best to purchase acrylic 4 or 4 oz yarn in a lighter color.

The cost of the class is \$5. This fee should be paid ahead of time so we can hold your space. The class size is limited so sign up soon. If there is enough interest we will schedule another class the following Monday.

If the class is canceled due to bad weather we will call the participants and reschedule the workshop.

Campbellsport Lions Club Donates Two New Computers to the Library

With much gratitude to the Campbellsport Lions Club, the Campbellsport Public Library will soon offer eight computer stations for patron usage. Each of these computers are linked to the internet and offer high speed surfing; which is perfect for job searching, completing class work and for social networking.

Plus all the computers are loaded with Microsoft Office programs such as Word, Power Point and Excel. Color or black and white print outs can be made from any of the computers for a minimal charge.

Resume paper and envelopes are also available for an added charge.

Every patron is given at least a half hour of uninterrupted use of a computer. If no one is waiting to use a station, patrons are welcome to stay as long as they would like to. If all the computers are full when you would like access, please talk to a staff member so we can secure you a space.

Use of the computers is free but you do need to have a valid library card.

If you don't have a card it takes just a few minutes to apply for one.

Laptop users are still invited to log onto our free wireless signal 24 hours, 7 days a week. The signal is accessible in the Library's parking lot.
