Summer Reading Program**

This summer the Library is again encouraging children to spend some of their summer time reading and participating in learning activities. In order to earn reading tickets that can be exchanged for great prizes, children will be asked to read at least, 10 to 20 minutes three times a week. We are again allowing the kids to include a visit to the library, attending library programming, doing a project at home or writing as their time put towards reading and learning. This year’s summer reading program for children ages 3 to 12 promises to be entertaining and educational. Programming for children age 8 and up will feature guest speakers who love and work with bugs! Programming for younger children will feature stories and activities about critters with numerous legs and/or wings.

Special features this summer will include a dog show featuring the *Soda Pups*. These little dogs will amaze everyone with their tricks.

This family friendly program will take place on Tuesday, June 24 at 5:30 pm. On Tuesday, July 22 at 5:30 pm the Library will be hosting a party. Tractors that the children can climb in will be the main attraction but we will also have face painting and a group craft activity along with a variety of other activities.

We will be celebrating everyone’s reading achievements on Wednesday, July 30 at 10:30 am with Judy Stock. Judy is a well known children’s programmer who will sing a variety of creepy crawly songs with the children.

Children are asked to sign-up for this program anytime the Campbelsport Public Library is open during the week of June 9th. Late sign-ups are accepted. When children sign-up for the program they will receive a free book bag and book mark, their reading logs, and a schedule of events. Children can participate in all of the activities at the Library or they can choose to only take part in the reading for prizes challenge, or they may just choose to attend any or all of the summer reading programs.

Teens and adults are not being left out of all the fun. A reading incentive program for both adult and teen readers is also being held. This program is easy to participate in and the possible rewards are great.
