Fond du Lac Senior Benefits Mini-Workshop and USDA Rural Development Home Repair Loan and Grants Informational Meeting

Wednesday, March 26 @ 10 am

Loan and grant assistance is available to make essential home repairs for low income elderly homeowners. Loan and grant funds can be used for weatherization purposes, electrical work, structural repairs, mound/septic, well work, or other essential repairs.

The eligibility requirements are the grant recipient must be 62 years of age or older. There are income and asset requirements. Applicant must own and occupy the single-family dwelling they wish to repair, loan applicants must have an acceptable credit history and value of property cannot exceed the maximum value limit for the county.

Following the Rural Development Home Repair Loan and Grant Program, Julie Hilbert, benefits specialist for Fond du Lac County will present a look at other benefits, programs and services that are available in Fond du Lac County.

Seniors who have contributed to society all their lives through work and taxes are possibly eligible for a wide range of benefits such as SeniorCare (Wisconsin's Prescription Drug Program), Homestead Tax Credit, Medical assistance, Property Tax Deferral Loan Program, HUD Housing, and a host of many other benefits, programs, and services.
