The Boy in the Striped Pajamas

This unique film tells the story of the Holocaust through the eyes of nine-year-old Bruno whose father is a Nazi commander at Auschwitz. Bruno strikes up a friendship with a Jewish boy, Shmuel, though the fence surrounding the camp where everyone wears striped "pyjamas." Their friendship will have startling and unexpected consequences for both of them.

This film is based on the modern children's fable, of the same title, written by Irish author John Boyne. This powerful tale quickly became a children's book that was also a must read for adults. The title appeared on the best sellers list not only in America but also in the UK, Ireland, Australia, Spain and many other countries.
