Kids of all ages are invited to join us on Wednesdays to learn about things such as foods we don't usually eat and to play gym games that children in other counties play. We will spend one week enjoying music from other countries and another learning about different kinds of art. That is just some of what is going on!

Children are strongly encouraged to participate in the portion of this program that encourages students to keep reading, writing and using their math skills during their summer vacation.
