

WE ARE ONLINE!

On September 26, 2005 the Campbellsport Public Library officially became part of the Winnefox Automated Library System. This means that our patrons are now able to access our card catalog through the internet. Library card holders will be able to reserve any books, music, or movies that they would like to check-out from our library or the 27 member libraries. Patrons will also be able to renew their checked-out library material.

Using the online card catalog is not only easy, it is also fun. You can access the catalog through our website www.campbellsportlibrary.org by clicking on the word catalog in the left hand column. Once you find an item you would like to borrow, to place a reserve on the item, click on the words *place reserve*. After doing this, a login screen will appear. You will need to type in the entire number from the back of your library card under the words *library card number*. **DO NOT TYPE IN SPACES OR DASHES IN YOUR LIBRARY CARD NUMBER!** Next to your library card number, type in your *PIN number*. Your PIN number is the last four digits of your phone number. Then click on *login*. A *place a reserve* screen will appear. Please check to see that Campbellsport is the pick-up location. If this is correct, please click on *submit reserve*. Once you have placed the reserve, a message should appear stating, *your reserve has been successfully submitted*. If the reserve you tried to place failed or if you are looking for an item that doesn't appear in the card catalog please call the library.

It is easier and faster to renew your items through the online catalog. Simply go to *your account*. You will need to type in your library card number and your PIN number. Click in the empty box next to the title of the item you would like to renew. A check mark should appear. Now click *renew items*. If your item is renewable, your item should be renewed (always double check.)

If you have not filled out a new library card application in the last 6 months, please stop in at the library to update your information so your library card will be valid on the new circulation system. As always, you will still receive quality assistance over the phone or in person at the library from any staff member.
