On Friday, November 6 and Saturday, November 7, 2009 we are hoping that people who enjoy the Library or even people who just love this community will volunteer to help us put a fresh coat of paint on some of the walls. If this project is completed by volunteers, more of the Library's budgeted funds can go toward things that will directly benefit our patrons such as books, movies and programming.

What areas of the Library get painted will depend on the number of volunteers. It is very important that you let us know that you will be here that day so we can purchase supplies.

There are also a few odd jobs that would be wonderful to have done that day. If the weather permits, the stall lines in the parking lot need to be painted and the windows need a good washing.

The chairs that are used around the tables and computers are covered in fabric. These chairs need to be cleaned. If someone has a home carpet cleaner and would be willing to come and scrub the chairs we would greatly appreciate it.

If you can't help on the 7th of November or if painting isn't something you are able to do and you would like to help out, please consider donating some kind of snack for the volunteers. If you are willing to do this please let a staff member know what you are contributing.


