Boundless Books for the Homebound

As the Wisconsin weather turns colder and the snow begins to fall, more and more of our neighbors have trouble leaving their homes to run everyday errands or to socialize. If your neighbor, friend or loved-one is in the unfortunate situation of being homebound, the Campbellsport Public Library may be able to bring some comfort into their lives through the delivery of library materials.

The Library has a large selection of novels in regular print and large print for the hard of seeing, non-fiction books, movies on DVD and VHS, books on tape and CD and music CDs all available through home delivery.

The participant can specify what items they would like delivered or they can allow a library employee to choose items for them according to their specified likes and dislikes. People who have access to the internet can place orders of what they would like to read or see through our website. Once the items are available, library staff or volunteers will be able to deliver their order at a convenient time.

Anyone who lives in the Village of Campbellsport or the surrounding townships may use this program. To use this service please call the Library at (920) 533 - 8534. The Library will mail out a short questionnaire, and create a delivery and pick-up schedule. This service may be used on a long term regular basis or occasionally as needs arise.

The Library is always looking for volunteers to help with this program. Not only do we need people to make deliveries, we also need people to spread the word.
