Six-year-old Jean Louise "Scout" Finch is growing up in the depression era of the early 1930s in a small Southern town in this highly acclaimed motion picture based on Harper Lee's semi-autobiographical novel. Jean's father, the town lawyer, is a wise, quite man with a great sense of justice who defends a poor, black man accused of rape.

The film won three Academy Awards including Best Actor for Gregory Peck.
