

## What we did over our summer vacation.

The Campbellsport Public Library was a place of constant activity this summer. During the months of June and July people borrowed 11,139 items from us. Individuals used the public internet stations 1,548 times. The summer reading activities were a lot of fun again this summer. Just under a thousand people attended these activities.

In August, the Library held its annual used book sale. Over a dozen volunteers helped organize the books. Fourteen tables were overflowing with great buys. This fundraiser was very successful. The funds will be used to enhance the Library's resources.

Library Volunteers did a great job this summer helping the staff complete a few large projects and numerous small projects. Volunteers labeled the children's books with Accelerated Reader tags, they helped weed the non-fiction collection, they organized shelves, filed some miscellaneous paperwork and helped with daily chores.

During the school year the Campbellsport Public Library will continue to provide quality and friendly service. Each month we will invite children and adults to take-in a movie at the Library. Ms. Katie has developed great plans for the story hour programs for tots.

The staff will continue to provide a variety of books and movies for all age groups to borrow for free. If there are items you are interested in but don't see on our shelves please talk to a staff member and we will help you get what you are looking for.

Volunteers are needed throughout the year for various projects. Right now we are in great need of people who are willing to read the shelves. This chore involves knowing you ABCs and 123s. Training for this job will take a matter of minutes and the project can be worked on anytime the Library is open.

Story hour programs are held every Wednesday at 10:30 am. The programs are designed for children between the ages of 3 and 6. The activities usually last for 45 minutes and can include listening to books, playing games, making a craft or sharing a snack.
