



If you have already created an account the specialist will help you check your account, review health plans and help you enroll!

No appointment is necessary. Please bring the following information with you: social security numbers (or document numbers for legal immigrants); Employer and income information for every member of your household who needs coverage; policy numbers for any current health insurance plans covering members of your household.

This free help is being provided by a certified enrollment counselor from SRA International under contract with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services U.S. Department of Health & Human Services.

Deep into a solo voyage an unnamed man wakes to find his 39-foot yacht taking on water after a collision with a shipping container left floating on the high seas. With his navigation equipment and radio disabled, the man sails unknowing into the path of a violent storm. Despite his success in patching the breached hull, his mariner's intuition and strength that belies his age, the man survives the tempest. Using only a sextant and nautical maps to chart his progress, he is forced to rely on ocean currents to carry him into a shipping lane in hopes of hailing a passing vessel. But with the sun unrelenting, sharks circling and his meager supplies dwindling, the ever-resourceful sailor soon finds himself staring his mortality in the face.
