Visit the Beyond with Professional Ghost Hunter Curt Strutz



October 28th @ 7 pm

During this *Visit the Beyond* presentation, Curt will take you into some of the nation's most haunted locations. He has visited battlefields, deserted asylums, historic locations, and known haunted residences around the USA. Photos, video and testimonies will be reviewed, as well as the history behind each location. These are not only great presentations for folks interested in ghosts and ghost hunting, but also for big time history buffs. Time is also spent discussing different tools used by a "ghost hunter" and possible theories about ghosts and haunted activity.

Curt Strutz's can be seen hunting ghosts on the television program *Paranormal Generation*. Go to paranormalgeneration.com to find out more about this show. When Curt is not hunting ghosts he performs as a professional stand up comedian, a ventriloquist and even a balloon artist.

Registration to attend this program is not required. This show is free and open to the public. The presenter warns that due to some of the content, such as some scary haunted activity and not-so-pleasant history of the locations this program is geared for teens and adults. Children under the age of 13 will need to be accompanied by a parent.
