No appointment is necessary. Please bring the following
information with you: social security numbers (or document num-
bers for legal immigrants); Employer and income information for
every member of your household who needs coverage (examples
paystubs or W-2 forms); policy numbers for any current health in-
surance plans covering members of your household.

This free help is being provided by a certified enrollment counselor from
SRA International, Inc. under contract with the Centers for Medicare &
Medicaid Services U.S. Department of Health & Human Services.
