Summer Reading - Fun for People of All Ages

People of all ages should stop by the Library during the week of June 10th to register for the Summer Reading program. When children register for the program they will receive a free book bag and bookmark, their reading logs, and a schedule of events. Children may choose to only take part in the reading for prizes challenge or they may just choose to attend programs at the Library or they may participate in all activities.

Teens are encouraged to sign up for the program. Kids ages 12 and up should stop in for their entry tickets and to pick up a bookbag and bookmark. Adults are not left out of the fun. When checking out a book or magazine grab some entry forms. Late sign-ups for all the Summer Reading programs are accepted.

Events for the Summer Reading program start on Wednesday, June 19th. At 10:30 that morning younger children are invited to the Library to listen to stories, play a gardening game, and to plant seeds. In the afternoon at 1, children ages 7 and older are encouraged to spend time with us learning about garden gnomes and making and eating dirt cake.

On Wednesday, June 26th kids are invited back to the Library to play gym games with Eden Elementary teacher Mrs. Salm. She will be playing Jurassic Park themed games at 10:30 am with the younger children. The older kids are invited to the Library at 1pm to play games with Mrs. Salm that move dirt.
