Mexican Immersion Experience - Evening Presentation

November 11 @ 6:30 pm

Join us to discover what it was like for two locals to travel to Cuernavaca, Mexico where they participated in a week long cultural immersion experience.

Gib Beine, along with his daughter Kelsey, travelled with 15 other Fond du Lac County residents to explore life in Mexico. During their journey, Gib and Kelsey participated in intense discussions relating to the context of immigration and the different social systems that affect the present day life in Mexico.

During their presentation, Gib and Kelsey will show slides and share stories that highlight the activities they did, the places they visited, and the people they met. You will hear about many of the issues in Mexico that are influenced by politics, economics, religion, and culture. Some highlights about their presentation include an excursion to the peoples market, home visits at a squatter settlement, building a home with Habitat for Humanity, touring an orphanage, and learning about environmental issues.

Accompanying Gib and Kelsey will be Marie Stafford, an immersion program planner who works with UW-Extension and the 4-H Youth Development Program.
