Jewelry 101 - How to Make Earrings

The ladies from Xpressions will be at the Library to teach participants how to make perfect earrings. They will explain the basic tools that you need and the skills that are required to make any type of earring. After the demonstration, there will be an opportunity for the students to make up to 4 different kinds of earrings.

All the earring designs are holiday inspired. Everyone can choose to make one type of earring, two of them or all. The options are snowman earrings for \$5, crystal Christmas trees for \$13, crystal angel earrings for \$8 and crystal snowflake earrings for \$13. Samples will be available to view at the Library.
